Pacific Flyway - 2022

January 27 - February 6, 2022

Reception: Friday, January 28, 2022

The Museum of Northern California Art is seeking original artworks, **all media including 3D**, whose subjects include wildlife and habitats along the Pacific Flyway, North and South for a juried exhibition to take place during Chico's **2022 Snow Goose Festival**. Along with traditional art forms, we are looking for work that somehow demonstrates a unique use of materials, subject matter and approach. The museum's exhibition committee will make the final selections for the exhibition.

The exhibit will be held at the Museum of Northern California Art (**monca**) 900 Esplanade in Chico, Thursday January 27 through Sunday February 6, 2022. The formal opening reception is Friday, January 28th, 5-8 pm. The reception is a free event for the community at large.

Deadline to Submit is January 7, 2022

ELIGIBILITY: Original works created by artists residing in Northern California, defined as San Jose and all points north, east, and west to the state border. All exhibited artworks must remain in the exhibition until 5 p.m. on the last day of exhibition.

To apply: Submit your art with [this form](#). Application fee of \$25 is due by January 7 at 5pm. The museum's exhibition committee will make the final choice of artists. Artists will be notified of the decision on or before January 12. **monca** will provide space and PR. All materials/equipment/supplies are provided by the artist. Restrictions: No hazardous materials in the gallery space.

ELIGIBILITY: Artist must be a resident of Northern California (defined as San Jose and all points north, east, and west to the state border.). Any exhibited artworks must remain in the gallery workspace until 5 p.m. on the last day of the residency.

 - **The form requires:** Artist's name, address, phone(s), email address, along with image files and info for each sample piece. Also, a space to upload a résumé or c.v..
 - **Image files and labeling:** Images should be in .jpg or .png format. Name the file with the artist's name followed by 1, 2, 3 etc. Example joesmith1.jpg

ENTRY FEE: \$25 (non-refundable): Payment (check, cash or credit card) must reach **monca** by **January 7**, at 5 pm

- Make check payable to **monca** and write "**Wings in Art - Pacific Flyway 2022**" application fee" in the memo. Your canceled check is your receipt

- For credit card payment, call 530.487.7272 or pay in person at **monca**, 900 Esplanade, Chico, CA Museum hours: Thursday - Sunday, 11-5

Jury notifications will be emailed on or before January 12, along with delivery/residency instructions.

IMPORTANT DATES

Deadline for entries and entry fee: January 7, 2022 at 5 pm

Jury notification: January 12, 2022

Delivery of work: January 13-16, 11 am - 5 pm and January 20-23, 11 am - 5 pm

Receptions: January 28, 2022 from 5-8 pm

After Exhibition: All works must be removed after 5 pm (once museum closes) on the last day of the exhibition, or February 10-13 between 11 and 5. Works left beyond February 13 will be assessed a storage fee of \$5 per piece, per day (Thurs-Sun).

Works left beyond March 11, 2022 will become the property of **monca**.

Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. monca will be diligent in the care of artwork but is not responsible for loss or damage that might occur.

ART DELIVERY

Onsite at 900 Esplanade on the following dates: January 13-16, 11 am - 5 pm and January 20-23, 11 am - 5 pm. Please follow current safety protocols. For any work for sale during the residency, please provide a price list with your name and artwork titles. The price should include a 50% museum commission. Prices will not appear on the gallery signage, but instead will be available on request at the reception desk.

ALL work must be delivered ready to hang or display. Works to hang on the wall must be wired; no sawtooth hangers. Any special display or hanging needs must be described in the application. 3D work must fit on a pedestal or have other means of display included.

Artist's name, phone, and title of work must be on the back of each artwork.

Please note

For anything needing to be shipped by **monca**, arrangements should be made in advance. Postage/packaging/shipping insurance are the responsibility of the artist and will be required upfront. The museum will not be held responsible for anything damaged in shipment.
